Mayflower Clinic

The concept of a charitable clinic has been in hearts and minds of many immigrants professionals from all over the world who settled in Wichita. Immigrant physicians were already volunteering their time at other charitable clinics, while others were seeing patients at no cost in their own offices.

The economic downturn, outsourcing and layoffs in the Wichita area resulted in many families without health insurance; some too young for Medicare or not poor enough for Medicaid while others simply cannot afford private insurance, creating a new group of at-risk members in our community.

The founders of Mayflower clinic realized the time was now for the successful immigrant professionals to step up and give back to this community that has enabled their success. The challenge was how to gather, harness and channel the talents, skills and generosity of the immigrant community into helping serve this target population free of charge. To put this concept into a reality, they enlisted their network of resources in the business, legal and medical community, resulting in opening of the Mayflower Clinic in October 2010

Vision:

The Mayflower Clinic envisions itself as part of a larger network of institutions addressing the health and well-being of the uninsured, mindful of the cultural, spiritual, social and economic realities that impinge upon them and the traditional barriers to accessing care.

Mission:

To provide access to basic and specialty health care to the uninsured in our community. We will do so through the efforts of immigrant professionals who want to THANK our community by giving back their talents, skills and generosity.

Mayflower Clinic Services

We are geared toward helping individuals or families that have recently lost health care coverage due to economic conditions and meet the following criteria:

- Have no health insurance of any kind.
- Not eligible for Medicaid, Medicare or other public insurance options.
- Not be under the care of another physician.
- Free Clinic - But donations are encouraged.
